The N.E.R.D.S. return as jealously grips tech giants who plan to crush them...with the moon!

N.E.R.D.S. π is planned to be the second sequel, based in London, England, three years after the second. The events of the previous film have not gone unnoticed. Throughout the world, the N.E.R.D.S. are famous, with Jake and Casper appearing on every media outlet, due to their exploits. In (most of) Europe, they are heralded as superheroes. Others, in America, Russia and China are less receptive. Billionaire owners of tech conglomerates in these countries set out to outdo each other in proving they are better than the N.E.R.D.S.

Following the events of the second film, the team are excited for more, but exhausted. They like the extra attention (to Jake and Casper) and the millions inspired by them, thousands becoming super-creative crime fighters. Though the team as a whole are looking to step away from the action and go back to their lives.

The death of Harrison in particular really hit the N.E.R.D.S. hard. They drew him in, rather than him joining purely out of interest, as the others (Ian, Raul & Phil) had. They felt responsible for this and did not want that kind of pressure resting on them again.

We see Jake and Casper touring the world appearing on top talk shows, discussing their crime-fighting. This is when the tech owners are really riled, as their companies are making huge advances to help humanity, further explore space etc. but they are being marginalised by media outlets because they are booked with meetings for the N.E.R.D.S.

At an unveiling of one owner's (China) new product it is gate-crashed by another (America), who openly challenges them to take on the N.E.R.D.S. Also being in the audience and not wanting to miss out on this, this other owner (Russia) jumps in stating they will do it. China then agrees and the deadly bet begins.

It is finally revealed why Black Kat feels she owes Jake's parents.

There are yet more advancement to Jake, Casper and Black Kat's super-suits. BattleUnicorn's is the same as the last film, as she did not want any enhancement.

Suddenly, almost out of nowhere, an army of (Russian) robots appears in a major European city and begins laying waste to civilians. The robots look like humans, but have massive guns attached to them (ADS Underwater gun).

This fight is relatively quick, with it leading underwater and Jake believing he is safe (knowing that normal guns cannot shoot underwater, nor do bullets). However, he is quickly corrected by the N.E.R.D.S. who are aware of the new Russian technology.

This next threat comes from China, initially with a handful of troops, which Jake laughs off, before they reveal they have “Cornershot”, a type of gun that can shoot around corners. As he is fighting his hidden enemies, tanks appear from behind quantum stealth camouflage, which is pointed out by Harry and Doc that they used it first. Finally, an Electromagnetic rail gun fires at them from a huge distance away. The N.E.R.D.S. manage to overcome them, but do not feel safe.

Prophecy tells them that the enemies are from various tech conglomerates and seem to be using more advanced technology. He jokes they will next use time-travel, which Jake believes and is mocked for.

When they re-convene, it is revealed that the next enemy is planning on blowing up the moon. Jake does not believe this, thinking he is being pranked and that no one would care.

The team tell him that, although unlikely, if the American is successful, the smaller chunks of moon would rapidly come closer into Earth’s orbit. Shortly after, the city-sized pieces would smash into Earth, each with the potential to destroy it completely.

Miraculously, Jake and Black Kat end up near the missile launch site and as it goes up, they follow it, with Black Kat carrying Jake.

As the warhead separates from the main rocket, Jake manages to attach it to his magnetised hand (left, as he is also magnetised to Black Kat with his right). While they continue to fly up to dispose of it in space, Black Kat is contacted by Prophecy telling her if she does not turn back now, she will not have enough fuel to return. There is already not enough for her and Jake to both come back and she knows this.

Black Kat switches off her comms with HQ, frustrating Prophecy. Prophecy contacts Jake, explaining the situation; that he cannot come back, but Black Kat can if she turns back now.

Jake thinks back to good times with Black Kat.

Jake looks over his shoulder, catching her eye. Jake says “I love you”, Black Kat (as per Han Solo) says “I know”. Jake then takes a deep breathe, aims the warhead away from Earth as best he can and Black Kat toward Earth.

Jake says “Hadouken!”, the word that fires the magnetised objects away from him. This propels the warhead away into the darkness of space and Black Kat toward Earth’s atmosphere. Black Kat screams “No!”, as she hurtles toward Earth. She regains control, landing safely, breaking down in tears as she takes off her helmet.

Jake is floating in space and will die.

The N.E.R.D.S. re-gather, the American is arrested, but the sadness is not alleviated from the team. They attend a funeral for Jake.

In a post-script scene, the team decide to keep fighting crime, as it is what Jake would have wanted.
